

MUSEUM OF ANTIQUITIES CHILDREN'S LIVING HISTORY WEEKEND WORKSHOPS:
Informed Consent, Permission and Waiver of Claim

I, the undersigned, the **Parent/Guardian** of _____, do hereby consent to his/her participation in the Children's Living History Weekend Workshop Program and related activities. I understand that the Children's Living History Weekend Workshop Program is designed to encourage an interest in history and will involve hands-on activities. The camp commences at 1:00 p.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m. on the date selected on the registration form. Camp organizers and their agents shall not be responsible for my son/daughter before or beyond the camp. A fee of \$20.00 per hour will be charged and the emergency contact may be called to pick up my child if I do not arrive at the end of the day by 4:00 p.m. If multiple people have permission to pick up my child I will indicate this on the registration form.

I agree that neither the University of Saskatchewan, the Museum of Antiquities, the Children's Living History Weekend Workshop Program organizers, or their respective employees, agents nor volunteers will be held liable for any injury to my child, or loss or damage to my child's personal property. I authorize the Children's Living History Weekend Workshop Program to provide or cause to be provided such medical services as the University or medical personnel consider appropriate.

Children who exhibit excessively disruptive or violent behaviour, including but not limited to: verbal, emotional, or physical abuse of fellow participants, workshop leaders, or volunteers, consistent refusal to adhere to safety guidelines and workshop rules, and wilful damage to personal, workshop, or Museum property will be removed by the leaders discretion and parents contacted. There will be no refund of workshop fees if this occurs. I understand this policy and the consequences of any inappropriate behaviour exhibited by my child.

As the parent or guardian of the above named participant, I have read and understood the terms and conditions outlined. The Children's Living History Weekend Workshop organizers reserve the right to cancel the workshop due to lack of funds, number of registrants, or any other reason at their discretion and, upon doing so, will refund the registration fee. They further reserve the right to refuse further participation to any participant for rule infractions. By signing this consent, I agree to allow the University of Saskatchewan and the Museum of Antiquities to take photos or videos (digital or otherwise) of my child and to reproduce the likeness of my child (no names or personal information to be used) in promotional materials, including brochures and audio-visual productions.
