SUBJECT: Potential Job Action By Canada Post Beginning May 25, 2011

We are providing important information for your consideration about the potential for job action by the Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW), which could begin May 25 (after midnight on May 24). Job action, if it were to occur, may take the form of work slowdown, rotating strikes or a strike by all members.

If you have time-sensitive materials to be delivered within Canada during this timeframe, you may wish to arrange to use a domestic courier service.

International and U.S. delivery of printed materials and small packages weighing less than two kilograms will be unaffected.

Internal university mail distribution will continue as usual.
