Wayne Nogier is an Instructor Trainer with the Canadian Red Cross First Responder and Emergency Medical Responder programs and has been delivering advanced emergency field training to Physical Therapists and Athletic Therapists since 1998.

Target Audience:

This course is targeted for Physical Therapists, Exercise Therapists, Athletic Therapists and anyone who regularly performs on-field emergency medical care and need to recertify to retain their credentials. Students in these disciplines may also take this course.

Pre-requisite Training:

All registrants MUST have current First Responder Certification and CPR (Basic Life Support Level C) certification. As of 2009 the Canadian Red Cross has a new three-year expiry on this program. Participants would have to have been certified in this program within 2007 to be eligible for this recertification.

Course Description:

This is a **two-day (20 hours) course**. The course meets the recertification requirements as a First Responder and is recognized by both the Canadian Medical Association and the Canadian Athletic Therapists Association for certification. The course content is 90% practical for the recertification. Typically, experience gained from this course would increase the emergency medical care that field trainers, physical therapists and athletic therapists could provide, and enhance timely referral to emergency medical services.

Course Text: Registrants should bring their First Responder textbook, workbook and a pen to the course. Some of the practical sessions can be strenuous so please wear or bring appropriate clothing.

NOTE: It is not a requirement to purchase a new text for the recertification program, but there is a new edition available this year. In the instructor's opinion, it is the best edition yet. For participants interested in purchasing a copy of this new text, the cost is \$99 plus tax, and it must be pre-ordered. **Please indicate on the registration form if you wish to order a copy of the new text.**

- CPR Health Care Provider "C" recertification
- Patient Assessment (including vitals)
- Mechanical Aids to Breathing (O2 Therapy)
- Spinal immobilization
- Special situations (Helmet and equipment removal)
- Other
