Duties: The successful candidate will perform a wide range of analyses involving biochemical and molecular biology techniques including standard cloning techniques and site-directed mutagenesis, protein purification and *in vitro* enzyme assays. The candidate is expected to carry out independent experiments under supervision and to maintain appropriate lab records and to ensure proper operation and maintenance of the laboratory and equipment.
