The Department of Small Animal Clinical Sciences, Western College of Veterinary Medicine, is seeking applications for a full-time, tenure-track faculty position in Emergency and Critical Care which is available July 1, 2011, or whenever a suitable candidate is identified. The level of appointment will be commensurate with the qualifications and experience of the candidate. The successful candidate must have a D.V.M. or equivalent degree, be licensed or eligible for licensure to practice in the Province of Saskatchewan, and should be a diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Emergency and Critical Care, or eligible for board certification with ACVECC. Possession of an advanced degree is desirable.

Teaching duties will be didactic and clinical instruction in Emergency and Critical Care, and related disciplines to undergraduate students, Interns, Residents and graduate students. Service activities include the management of patients and consultation in the Veterinary Teaching Hospital and administrative activities. The candidate will be expected to pursue research consistent with the goals of the Department and College. Extensive opportunities for collaborative research exist within the College and the University.
