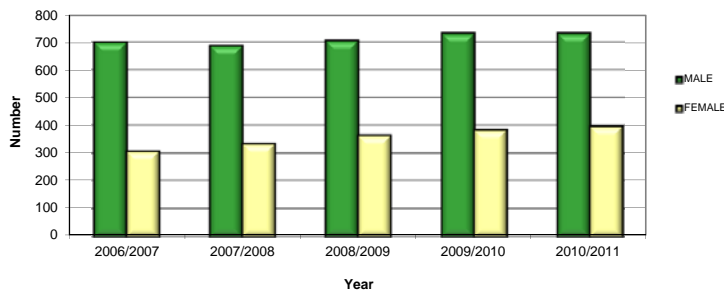

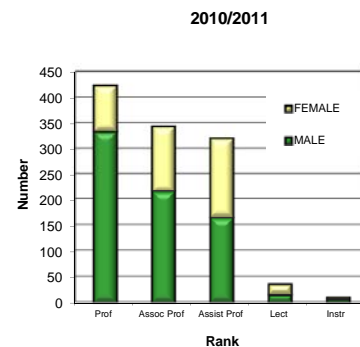

NOTE:

Effective 1991/92 full-time include:

- New appointees hired on a full-time basis whose term of contract is 12 months but for the first year they can only be at the institution for less than 12 months.
- Staff who were appointed to teach full-time and at a later date have entered into a formal agreement with the institution to carry a fraction of a normal full-time load. This situation usually arises with staff members who are approaching retirement.

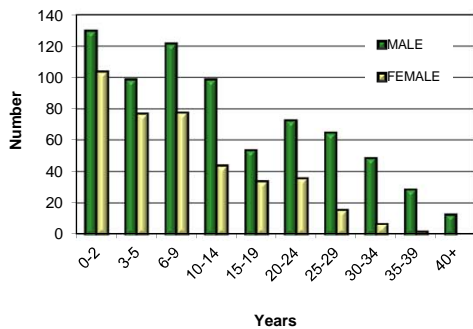

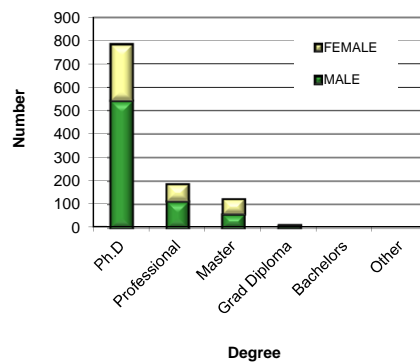

Highest Degree (2010/2011)

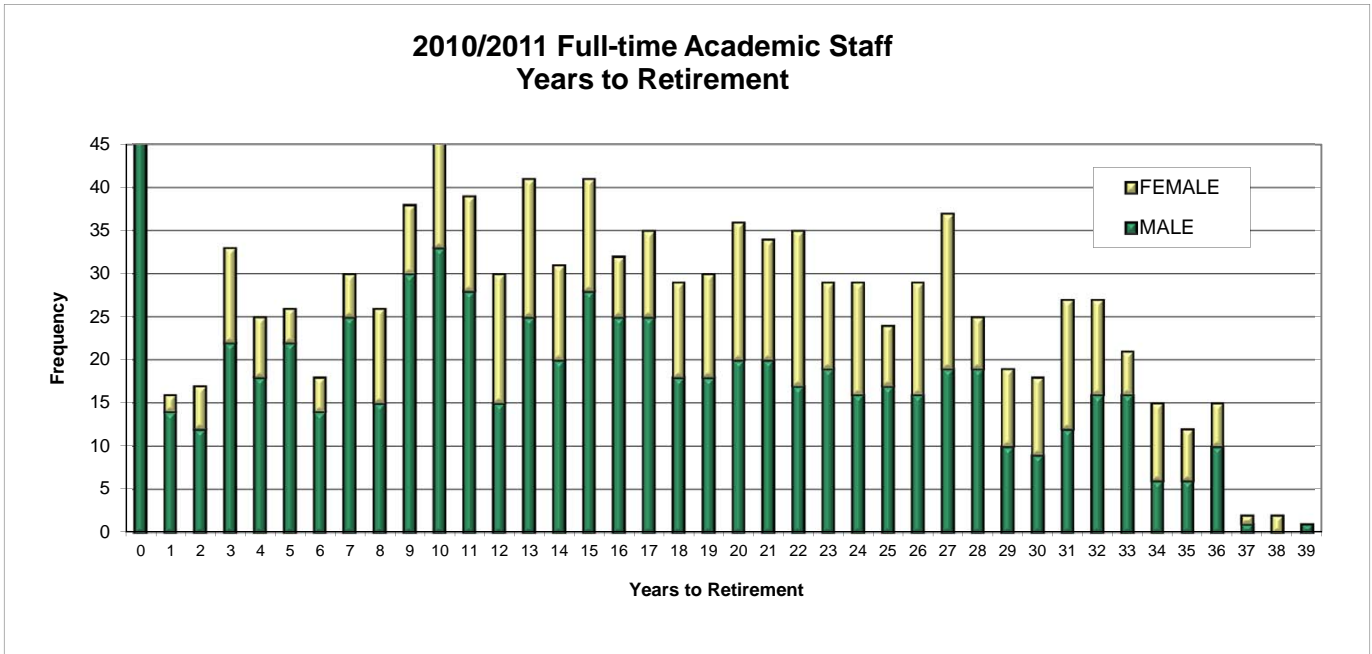

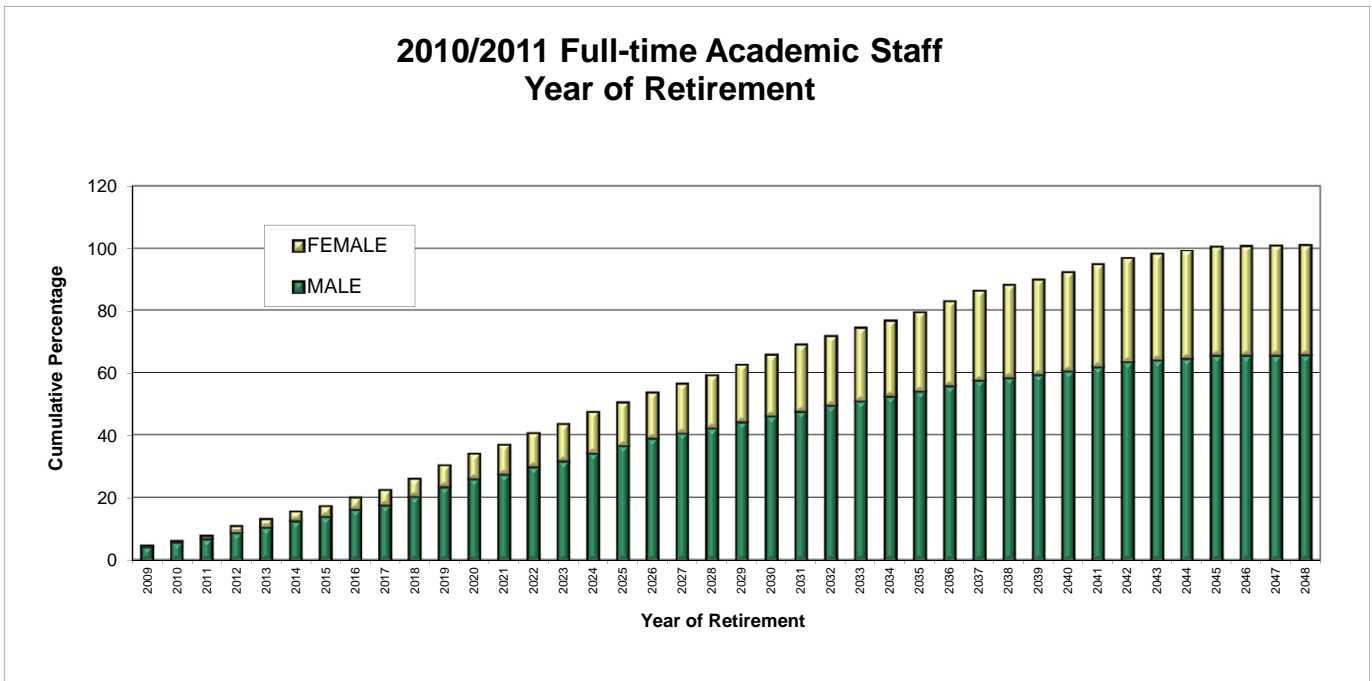
