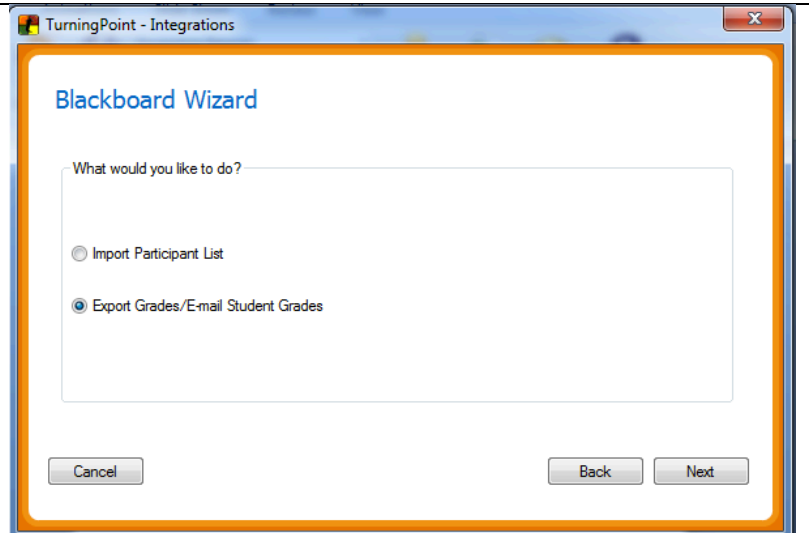
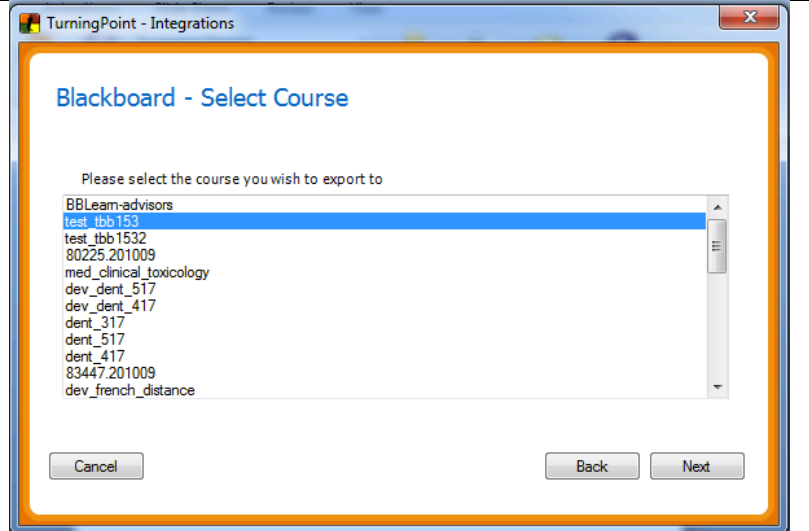


Late-Breaking news for Clicker users – Uploading Clicker “Grades” to the BBLearn Grade Centre

To UPLOAD Turning results to the BBLearn Grade Centre, you need to follow the instructions in the previous Clicker Integration document up to and including Step 4 (this is the process by which you get connected to Blackboard from TurningPoint). Once you reach the step shown below, select Export Grades/Email Student Grades.



Next, select the class into which you want to upload grades. Again, you will need to know the CRN.Term (see the example in the previous document for where to find your course’s CRN.Term) in order to choose it from your course list.



In the next window, select a Turning Session File that contains grade information you want to upload, and provide a column name to be created in the Grade Centre. You should see a list of students and their attendant grades appear in the top portion of the window.

When you click Finish, Turning will upload the "grade" information into the Grade Centre in BBLearn...

Now, you need to be aware of a few things about structuring your clicker questions to make this work. To create the "grade" you are uploading, Turning adds together all the Answer Point values in all the questions that have a correct answer indicated for them... So in the example information to the right, I assigned 100 points to the correct answer for this question and marked Answer 2 as the correct response. If this were the ONLY question in my presentation, students who answered "2" would receive a "grade" of 100.

If I had 2 questions worth 100 points, the grade assigned would be 200 points.

So, if you want to upload "grade" information you need to ensure that you:

1. Have a Correct answer value set for each question you want included,
2. That you have a point value assigned for the correct answer for each of the questions that HAVE a correct answer...
