The College of Nursing:

PAWS:

PAWS is your **P**ersonalized **A**ccess to **W**eb **S**ervices at the U of S. PAWS is personalized to you and can be customized by you. When you log on to PAWS, you'll find channels with information and services specific to your role at the University.

You will use PAWS to find out your registration access date and to register for your classes.

To log on to PAWS, you will need your NSID and password. If you do not know your NSID, or you have forgotten your password, contact the ITS Help Desk at 966-4817.

Please note that you will be responsible for registering for all of your U of S classes, including the XNEP 001 classes for May to December. The XNEP 001 classes indicate to the University of Saskatchewan community that you are a current nursing student while you are taking SIAST classes.

Listed below are the course reference numbers (CRNs) for the XNEP 001 classes for May to December 2009. You must register for all 3 of the XNEP 001 classes. You will be able to register for the 200905 & 200907 XNEP 001 classes beginning February 26, 2009. Registration for the 200909 XNEP 001 class will begin in June 2009. Access dates have not yet been posted.

Health and Dental Insurance:

Students that are full-time and on-campus pay student fees for the September to April terms which automatically include Health and Dental fees. Since the NEPS SDEO starts in May, the Health and Dental Plan is not available to you until September. ****Please note:** The full-time student fees which include the Health and Dental plan allow students to have Health and Dental coverage for the policy year September 1 to August 31. Therefore, students that were at the U of S full time from September to April previous to the May start date of the NEPS SDEO, will have paid the student fees that include the Health and Dental plan (unless the students opted out of the plan). These students will continue to have Health and Dental coverage until August 31.

PAC:

During the summer you are assessed less student fees than during the September to April terms. Because of the reduced fees, you are not paying to use the PAC. If you would like to access the PAC during the summer, you must take out a monthly membership with the PAC. ****Fees are subject to revision. PAC access subject to change.****

UPASS/Student Card/Library Card:

The U-PASS is a universal bus pass valid September to April for all undergraduate students which allows unlimited use of Saskatoon Transit. The U-PASS sticker can be picked up at the Information Centre in Upper Place Riel. You will need to get your student card prior to picking up the ticket as the UPASS sticker is affixed to your U of S student card. Visit the U of S Bookstore to obtain your student card.
