PROGRAM INFORMATION

This course has been designed to train Level I pharmacists in the processes of prescribing for minor ailments. This is the next step Level I training. Guidelines for a number of minor ailments developed by the team at the Saskatchewan Drug Information Services As of March 2011 three minor ailments guidelines. An Interdisciplinary Committee of practitioners is reviewing

The first modules for minor ailments will be offered in two delivery methods. We will be offering another live version in September in Saskatoon only and an online version of the course will be available August 2011.

All pharmacists must take either the online or live version of the training to be allowed to prescribe for minor ailments.

If you choose not to participate in this second offering of training in prescribing for Minor Ailments, you can complete the required training in the future as additional conditions are approved for prescribing. In other words, you only need to take the training ONCE, and can prescribe for all approved minor ailments as soon as you have been trained. CPDP will develop modules for new areas as they become approved. Availability of "live" training sessions will be dependent on the timing of approval for any new conditions. We may hold additional live sessions in the future; on-line modules will be made available as conditions are approved.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE:

In the future as new minor ailments become approved for prescribing, you can complete online modules to prescribe for them. Modules will be offered for pharmacists who wish to review those ailments prior to prescribing. Guidelines for prescribing will appear on the SDIS website when approved.
