

2011 – 2012 SENS Photo Contest

Terms of Reference

1. The contest is open to all SENS students and alumni. Multiple submissions are allowed and encouraged.
2. The photo contest runs from September 6, 2011 to April 30, 2012.
3. Photos must be submitted to sens.info@usask.ca along with the online form provided. Entrants must specify the submission category. The four categories are:
 - a. The natural environment
 - b. The urban environment
 - c. Research and student life
 - d. Sustainable community
4. Photos submitted must be larger than 1 MB.
5. Photos will be posted online and judged by the SENS community via email ballot. Faculty, staff, students and alumni may fill out one ballot for each category.
6. The top three photos in each category will be judged and the top photos selected via a committee of up to six members comprised of selected faculty members, staff, students and alumni. The SENS Communications Specialist will be one of the judges on the committee. The committee reserves the right to select a fourth picture in each category and judge them amongst those chosen via email ballot. Selected winners in each category will receive a cash prize of \$50.
7. The judging committee will also select an overall winning photo from amongst the four category winners. This photographer will receive an additional cash prize of \$100.
8. The winning photos may be displayed in the third-floor elevator lobby in Kirk Hall and/or mounted on walls in the SENS hallways. Winners will also be mentioned in the *Talking SENSE* and *Alumni Sensor* newsletters.
9. Submitted photographs remain the property of the photographer. However, upon submission of a photograph, the photo contest entrant grants SENS non-exclusive, transferable, royalty free, worldwide license to use the submitted photograph for use in promotional material. SENS reserves the right to showcase all winning photographs indefinitely on our website and building hallways. SENS rights shall not include the sale of submitted photographs to other parties or other commercial use. Photo credits will be provided where possible at SENS' sole discretion.
