

THE LORRAINE SOMMERS GRISLIS TRAVELING SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship shall be awarded to the candidate who has excelled in academic work, shown creative interest in women's studies and exhibited religious seriousness.

The award is given for the purpose of further study at the fully accredited institution or in an accredited professional program other than the Lutheran Theological Seminary. Types of study may include masters, Ph.D. or doctorate in ministry programs or chaplaincy preparation.

The scholarship is awarded annually and is renewable pending the student's successful continuation in the program and reapplication.

The current annual value of the scholarship is available upon request.



LORRAINE SOMMERS GRISLIS
(February 21, 1932 – October 9, 1995)

Pastor Grislis was born in Republic, Michigan in a Finnish Lutheran home. She earned B.Sc., M.A., M.Div., and D.Min. degrees. Ordained in 1975 by the Lutheran Church in America she first served Redeemer Lutheran Church in Yonkers, New York. She also served St. Luke's congregation and led the parish through the construction of their building. Her Canadian tenure included Prince of Peace Lutheran Church in Winnipeg and St. Paul's Lutheran in Brunkild, Manitoba. Upon completion of chaplaincy training, Pastor Grislis served at St. Boniface Hospital and Health Services Centre in Winnipeg as the oncology chaplain. Known for her fine preaching and splendid service in ministry she was a shining example of faith active in love.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Eligible persons are Master of Divinity graduates of the Lutheran Theological Seminary Saskatoon.

Applicants for the scholarship must submit a letter with the application form which will include: a description of her or his interest in women's studies, a statement of religious seriousness and a vision of her or his future educational endeavours.

Applicants should also submit two letters of reference from people who can speak to their academic ability.

The Scholarship will be awarded in May of each year for the academic year beginning the following September.
