**JONATHAN A. DRAPER**, PhD, is a professor of New Testament at the School of Religion & Theology, University of Kwa-Zulu Natal (Pietermaritzburg, South Africa). He is also an ordained Anglican priest in the Church of the Province of South Africa.

Draper has edited several books: *The Didache in Modern Research* (1997), *The Eye of the Storm: Bishop John William Colenso and the Crisis of Biblical Interpretation* (2004), *Orality, Literacy, and Colonialism in Southern Africa* (2004), and *Orality, Literacy, and Colonialism in Antiquity* (2004). He is co-editor with R. A. Horsley and J. Miles Foley, *Performing the Gospel: Mark, Orality and Memory* (2006) and with Cynthia Kittredge and Ellen Aitken, *Reading the Signs of the Times: Taking the Bible into the Public Square* (2008). He is the current editor of *Neotestamentica*, the Journal of the New Testament Society of South Africa. Dr. Draper co-authored with Richard Horsley *Whoever Hears You Hears Me: Prophets, Performance, and Traditions in Q*.
